REGULAR SEASON LEAGUE FORMAT



YOUNGER AGE GROUPS

For the 13U and 14U age groups, the Elite 64 league season will offer a minimum of 14 league games (per group of 8) that can be scheduled and managed by the clubs over a full 10-month period, as players of this age are generally unaffected by high school soccer.

OLDER AGE GROUPS

For the 15U, 16U, 17U and 18/19U age groups, the Elite 64 league season will offer a minimum of 14 league games (per group of 8) over a 10-month period. The schedule will be created and managed by the clubs to aid players' periodization and involvement in high school soccer.

SCHEDULING OPTIONS

Multiple scheduling options are available to accommodate travel concerns and allow for clubs to complete their league season in the most sensible way possible.

- Home/Away Each club hosts the other clubs in its group one time and travels to each of the opposing clubs in its group one time.
- **Event-based** Multiple clubs come together in a single city and/or venue to compete against two or more other clubs from within their group.
- **Hybrid** Clubs fulfill their matchups with select opposing clubs in a home/away format, while facing other clubs in an event-based format.

ELITE 64 SHOWCASES

Each team in every tier is guaranteed three games at the Elite 64 National Finals.

EVENT SCHEDULE

For each gender, the 16U, 17U and 18/19U age groups will play early in the event, and the 13U, 14U and 15U age groups will play later in the event. Each team will compete over three days (three games). The teams that advance to the title match in the Finals Bracket will play their final match (fourth game) on their fifth day of the event following a rest day.

NATIONAL FINALS TEAM CHAMPION



FINALS BRACKET

Featuring the top two regular season teams from each group, the Finals Bracket allows teams to compete to become the Elite 64 Team Champion in each age group.

FORMAT

The Finals Bracket follows a format similar to the World Cup knockout rounds, beginning with a Round of 16, followed by Quarterfinals, Semifinals and Finals.

Teams who do not advance past the Round of 16 (Day 1) or Quarterfinals (Day 2) play games on the subsequent days against equivalent competition that count toward Club Champion points (giving them 3 games total).

Note: Any game with advancement implications in the Finals Bracket that ends in a tie after regulation will go straight to kicks from the mark to determine the advancing team.

NATIONAL FINALS CLUB CHAMPION



The Club Champion recognizes the club with the best cumulative performance across all age groups at the Elite 64 National Finals. All tiers (Finals, Tier 2, Tier 3, Tier 4) contribute to the overall Club Champion point totals — adding meaning to each game played at the Elite 64 National Finals.

FORMAT

For each game, teams can earn 3 points for a win; 1 point for a tie; and 0 points for a loss. Those points will be added to the Club Champion point totals.

A multiplier will be applied to points earned in each tier:

- Finals Bracket...... 4x points earned
- Tier 2...... 3x points earned
- Tier 3...... 2x points earned
- Tier 4......1x points earned

The multiplier gives added weight to the higher tiers and adds importance and meaning to every regular season game, as each individual spot in the group standings matters.

Once all games are complete, the overall point totals will be compiled and the club with the highest cumulative point total across all age groups will be crowned the season's Elite 64 Club Champion.





REGISTRATION FAQS



What is the process to register Elite 64 coaches and team officials with USYS with regards to risk management?

USYS will be conducting background checks through JDP at the registered coach's expense. Given the nature of Elite 64, JDP highly recommended the Pro Package to properly cover individuals located across the United States. The Pro Package includes:

- SSN ID Search

How will parents/guardians sign the State Association Medical Release?

We will require the parent(s)/Guardians to sign a USYS Medical Release. This information will then be forwarded to the State Associations.

Who will be providing player insurance and health coverage?

The broker for player insurance and health coverage will be <u>Player's Health</u>, which will provide...

- General Liability
- Medical
- Process for Filing Claims

How will player transfers/releases be communicated to the State Association?

Any player transfer releases must be sent to both USYS and their State Associations. Most transfer releases will need to be done in accordance with the respective State Association's rules and processes, however, Elite 64 to Elite 64 specific transfers will be handled by USYS.

When can a player be added to a club's Elite 64 player pool?

An Elite 64 club can add players to its Elite 64 player pool at any time during the seasonal year. In order to maintain the high level of competition, Elite 64 clubs may host talent identification sessions at any time during the seasonal year and recruit players from non-USYS-affiliated clubs at any time during the seasonal year.

Elite 64 does not mandate player/talent identification take place at specific times of the year.

GENERAL CLUB STANDARDS

All clubs must meet the following summary of minimum standards:

- Fulfillment of the 3-year requirement for each club
- · Commitment to a safe and challenging game day and environment
- Capture all league game footage and upload to Elite 64 video server
- Host club covers referee and field fees for league games
- Commitment to sportsmanship, both on and off the field

CLUB EVALUATION

Over the course of each 3-year cycle, clubs will be evaluated based upon criteria that includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Administration & communication
- On-field performance
- STATSports data
- ProScore data
- Fulfilling fixtures
- Commitment to Elite 64 National Finals and showcases
- Commitment to enhancing Elite 64 events via college coach outreach
